- Provides meals to students during designated meal times.
- Manage food inventory and storage.

- Fulfill kitchen responsibilities for annual events and work teams.
- Provide appropriate training and management for all kitchen staff and volunteers.

- Must affirm the basic doctrinal statements of ABI.
- Must be eligible and able to obtain state regulatory licensure for kitchen management.

- Must have experience in operating a commercial kitchen.
- Must have the ability to communicate effectively in English, both in spoken and written form.
- Exemplary planning, time management skills, and a demonstrated ability to multitask.
- Must be able to work diligently both independently and in team settings.
